

Bingo - Nevada Report



Our Bingo program has been very successful so far this year which has made it possible to finish our commitment to the Ajax Library as well as pay off part of our sponsorship for the Ajax Legacy Obelisk. We have received \$50,909.74 to date.

It would not be possible without the support of our three Branch members, Dawne, Anna & Joanne, who faithfully run our session no matter what day or night they fall on.

These funds have been used to

- Pay the bank loan / interest \$18,242.56
- Run our monthly Seniors Luncheons \$5,207.76
- Cover some building expenses \$6,966.05
- Library Donation \$10,000.00
- Ajax Legacy Obelisk \$4,500.00
- Made donations to our community \$8,200.00



We raised 55,835.00 in proceeds so far this year with our Nevada Break Open Ticket program. After deducting our License fees, ticket costs and payouts, we have netted 10,254.56.

We have been able to direct \$3,784.00 to our Building account and \$2,535.28 to the General account under the lottery license regulations.

Thank you to all the Branch members who buy the Nevada tickets to help support our Branch and to Rita Cooke who does Nevada during our Saturday Meat Draw.
