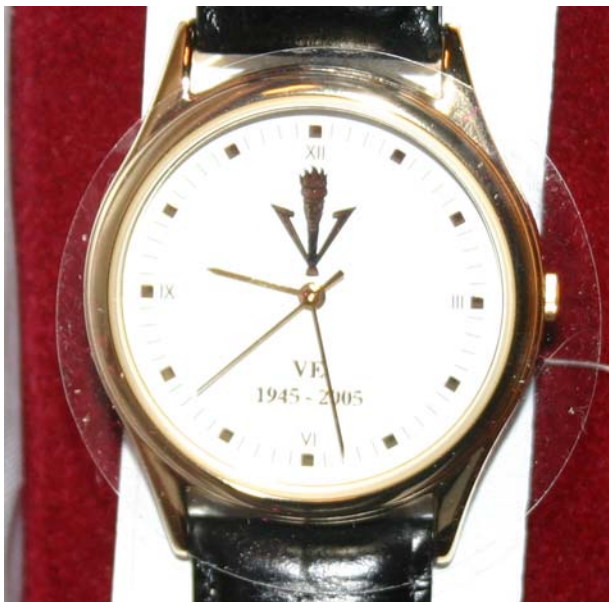


# Veteran's Dinner
